Gods and Goddesses Mini Project



There are too many gods and goddesses to count. Each god and goddess in Greek mythology had their own special powers and abilities. Who was the strongest? Was it Zeus, Hera, Athena, or Poseidon? As a class, we will determine if the men (gods) or women (goddesses) were the most powerful! Consider it a battle of the sexes!

Procedure:

- Work in groups of 2
- Research your assigned god or goddess and find the following:
- Special power
 - Symbol
 - Pictures (may be clip art or from the Internet)
 - Relevant story about the god or goddess that effectively show his or her personality and role in the world of deities.

Product:

You will use Microsoft Powerpoint to create a snapshot of the deity.

Your Powerpoint must be **5 slides**:

Slide 1: Title Page containing name of each group member, Name of god or goddess, Teacher name, Date, Block number.

Slide 2: A picture or pictures of the deity and his or her name.

Slide 3: Pictures of deity's symbol(s) and an explanation of these symbols.

Slide 4: Description of his/her special powers and how he/ she uses it.

Slide 5: A brief, relevant story about the deity (in your own words).
